- (1) FIR No.18 of 2015 registered with N. M. Joshi Marg Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 295A and 34 of the IPC.
- (2) FIR No.71 of 2015 registered with Mumbra Police Station, Thane City for offences punishable under Sections 295A and 34 of the IPC.
- (3) FIR No.23 of 2015 registered with Rabodi Police Station, Thane City for offences punishable under Sections 295A and 34 of the IPC.

(4) FIR No.10 of 2015 registered with Nizampura Police Station, Thane City for offences punishable under Sections 295A and 34 of the IPC.
